



Accommodations

Bigelow Lodge

Sleeps 10 to 12 guests; fully furnished, galley kitchen, (cooking utensils and dishes provided) bathroom w/ shower, large fieldstone fireplace, lake views and access, canoe. Guests must provide all bed and bath linens.

5 Cabins

Each cabin sleeps 6-8 guests, fully furnished, fieldstone fireplace, bathroom w/ shower, galley kitchen (cooking utensils and dishes provided) heat, screened porch, lake views and access. Guests must provide all bed and bath linens for cabins.

18 Campsites

Each campsite equipped with electrical and water hook-ups, fire ring and picnic table. Sites are suitable for RV, pop-up or tent camping.

Bath house with toilet facilities located near sites. There is an on-site waste disposal station located near the campsite area.

2 Yurts

One Yurt is located on a remote site at King Pond (canoe, boat or kayak required to access location) A second Yurt is located on the Great Pond grounds.

Campers/Pop-Ups

A limited number of on site Campers and Pop-Up Campers are available for rent to those without their own. See Rate List for charges.

Recreation Hall

Large communal space with large fieldstone fireplace, recreation equipment (pool tables, ping pong, board games, etc), large screen TV, toilet and shower

facilities and kitchen as well as washer-dryer facilities.

Four Seasons at Great Pond

Outdoor Adventure Center

Summer

Camping, boating (canoe or motor powered, sail-boat or kayak), swimming (at your own risk, no life guard available), hiking, fishing, enjoyment of nature

Fall

All of the above while weather permits and hunting and fall foliage

Winter

Outdoor enthusiasts may enjoy winter camping, snowshoeing, ice fishing, and cross country skiing in the Maine woods

Spring

Camping, hiking, fishing (when pond is clear of ice)

Policies and Procedures

Reservations:

Authorized Patrons may make reservations up to 12 months in advance by calling the MWR Information, Tickets and Travel Desk in the RecMall, Naval Air Station, Brunswick, at (207) 921-2113. Daily, weekly and weekend rates are available.

Deposits

A 50% deposit (cash, check or credit card) is required to confirm a reservation. Balance is due upon check in at Great Pond OAC. Payment in full may be paid at the ITT Desk prior to check in as well.

Check-In/Check-Out

Check in is 2 pm. Check out is at 11 am. Late check out will be charged an additional days fee after 11 am.

Cancellation Policy

Full refund of deposit will be given if cancelled 7 days or more from check in date
Cancellation less than 7 days: No Refunds.

Early Departure

NO REFUNDS for early departure.

Pet Policy

Pets are allowed at Great Pond with a \$5 per day charge payable upon registration. ALL PETS MUST BE LEASHED. Guests with pets are required to clean up pet waste immediately. Guests with pets that cause disruption or damage to the property or to other guests, may be asked to leave for the safety and comfort of all.

Trash Disposal

All guests of Great Pond Outdoor Adventure Center are responsible for the disposal of all trash generated by them during their stay. This applies to guests in the cabins, lodge or campsites. Guests must remove trash via provided plastic bags to the nearest disposal container to their accommodations.



Directions to Great Pond

From NAS Brunswick Maine:

- At Cooks Corner, take Route #1 South briefly
- Exit via the Brunswick By-Pass follow signs to I-95 North
- Continue on I-95 North to Exit 45A which is I-395
- Travel I-395 to exit 6A
- Turn left on to Route # 46
- Turn right on to Route # 9 for approximately 18 miles
- Turn left at the Great Pond Business District sign
- Continue for 1.4 miles
- Turn left on to Great Pond Road
- Continue on Great Pond Road to the end (approximately 7 miles)
